

3805 RUFFLED SCARVES

Version 1: ANGORA X TWO **SIZE:** approx 3" x 46"

MATERIALS:

2 skeins Angora, # 10 needle
With either Angora, CO 96 sts.

Row 1: K and inc 1 in each st across—192 sts.

Row 2: *Inc in next st, inc in next st, k 1; rep from *.
320 sts.

Knit 6 rows. BO all sts.

With 2nd Angora, pick up 192 sts in CO row.

Next row: rep row 2 from above. Finish as for 1st skein.

Version 2: TULLE & ANGORA

2 skeins Tulle, 1 skein Angora

Work base ruffle with Tulle.

Work Angora for 2nd ruffle.

Repeat 2nd ruffle on other side of Angora with Tulle.

FROSTY RUFFLES

MATERIALS:

2 Frost

Crochet hook size I

Ch 180. Work 1 sc in ea chain, then ch 5, and without turning, work 8 treble crochet in end of row; then cont down back side of sc strip, work 2 tc in each sc st; work 8 tc in end of row; then 2 tc in ea sc along other side.

*A crocheted version works up quickly in Frost.
A single scarf, right, in Blue Lagoon can become
oh so much more when paired with another scarf in
Woodlands, as in the detail below. Go nuts!*
